Incorporate erosion control measures on unvegetated slopes within State right-of-way. Pave existing unsurfaced pullouts and driveway connections. Post Mile 24.9 to PM 27.2. Caltrans EA 1A845.

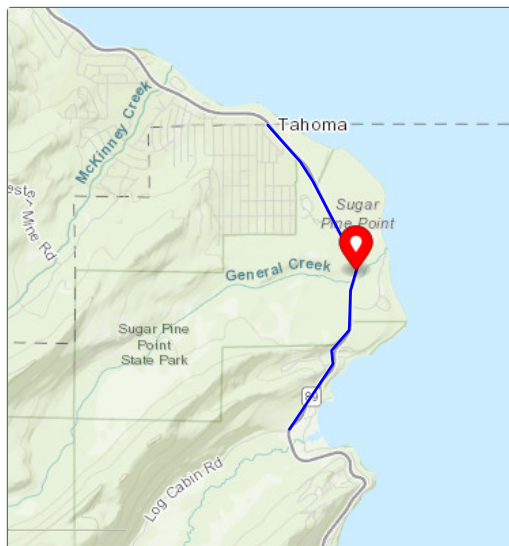
