The primary objective of the project is to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfires that could damage Lake Tahoe Basin forests, watersheds, habitats, and communities and increase the pace and scale of fuel reduction in the park and recreation area. Once completed, state implementers can efficiently and comprehensively evaluate the effects of forest management, and improve the project approval and delivery process for subsequent activities.


