This work will be done in coordination with the Tahoe Fire and Fuels Team (TFFT) and other Basin partners. Once implemented, the fuels reduction and wildfire prevention projects will help to restore the resilience of Basin forests and watersheds, foster Basin-wide climate change adaptation and reduce fire risk for communities.

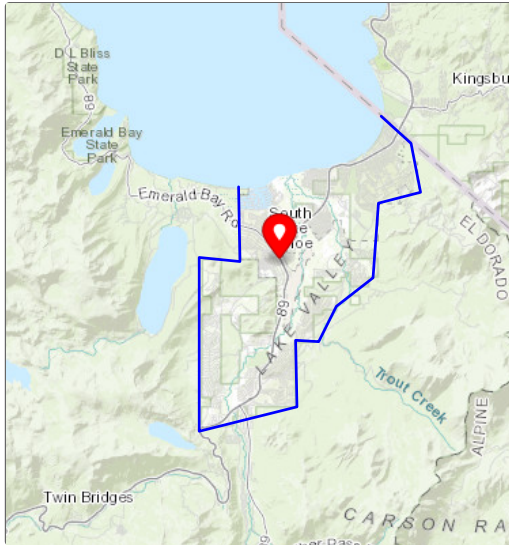
