The pier and path to the historic core of the Vikingsholm estate are not ADA accessible from the lake.

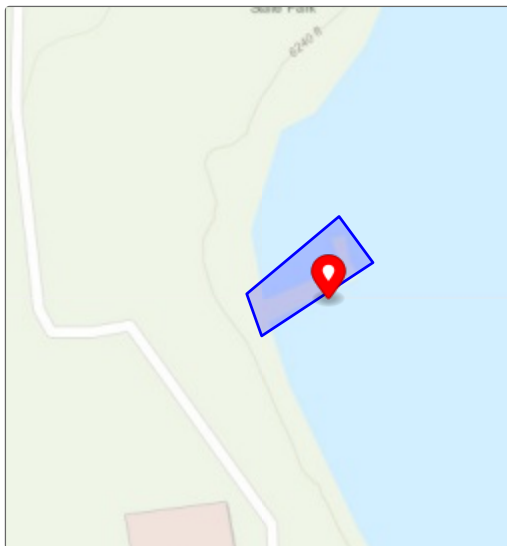

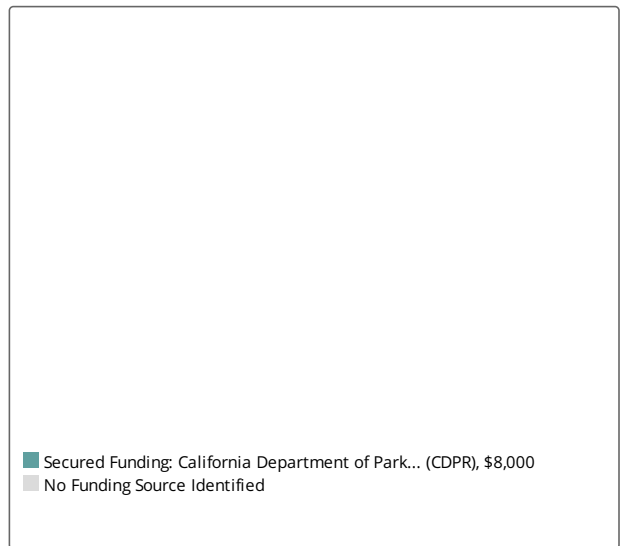
